Jazz In The Country (JIC) Benefit Jazz Festivals are the brainchild of Rev. Larry Robinson, Pastor of Little Ark Baptist Church here in King George. His congregation is one of 20+ member churches of the Mt. Bethel Baptist Association of DC, MD & VA, owners of the Mt. Bethel Retreat Center.

Mt. Bethel Retreat Center property was acquired in 1898 for a mere \$600 and sits on 75 acres of land known as Mathias Point, overlooking the Potomac River. In its early days, the Retreat Center served as a safe haven for African Americans at a time when not given entry to most public establishments. Atop the current "Mansion" building sits a lookout room used to keep watch for the Ku Klux Klan during tense times. The Retreat Center was a favorite site for church and family gatherings, reunions and other social events. That tradition is still alive today. Known for her exceptional tone, intoxicating melodies, and flawless technique, she is one of the most sought-after flutists in both the classical and jazz fields.

member of the all-female jazz supergroup Jazz in Pink, alongside other musicians such as

Touted as the next Stevie Wonder, Matthew Whitaker's love for playing music began at age 3, after his grandfather gave him a small Yamaha keyboard. At 9, Matthew began teaching himself how to play the Hammond B3 organ. Four years later, he became the youngest artist to be endorsed by Hammond—in its 80+ year history. He was also named a Yamaha Artist at 15, becoming the youngest musician to join the stellar group of jazz pianists.

In 2018, The Root added Matthew to its list of one of 25 Young Futurist Leaders and was named as one of seven rising stars for 2018 by USA Today network's 201 Magazine; and he received The Harlem Stage Emerging Artist Award.

In 2019 & 2020, Matthew was a winner of The ASCAP Foundation Herb Alpert Young Jazz Composers Award for his original compositions "Emotions & Underground!" More at www.matthewwhitaker.net

The BRENCORE ALLSTARS have performed many Tributes, selling out venues such as The Historic Howard Theatre, The



Founded in 2020, Sound Fusion is inspired by the jazz-funk fusion sounds that emerged in the 1970s, as well as tunes that predate that era. It all started with a request for a group to perform at a virtual concert sponsored by a local Fredericksburg VA library. Drummer/producer Kyle Smith assembled the group and recorded the concert in his basement.

Sound Fusion's first demo, a cover of the classic tune "My Favorite Things", received regular rotation on local radio during the December 2020 holiday season.
